Librarian role and responsibilities

- Leading Library lessons with all year groups focused on the individual needs and developmental stages of classes, year groups and individuals.
- These lessons include; teaching phonics and early ages literacy in English primarily but also in Sepedi; sound and movement lessons, book reviews, presentations, poems, reading aloud, storytelling, speeches and 'presenting the weekend news' on a Monday morning.
- Keeping up with national and international progress in literacy and library trends.
- Developing yearly whole school themes such as 'Reading for Understanding'
- Coordinating 'Library week' on a termly basis which entails involving the local community, parents and teachers in the Library's theme
- Supporting other educators in developing the use of the library- for example for researching teaching material or setting research assignments and homework.
- Coordinating and encouraging the loan of books to learners, including, when books are returned, checking the students understanding of the book through questioning.
- General library maintenance, inventory keeping, etc.
- Quarterly reports sent to St Marks Trust
- Reading skills testing of students to monitor progress.
